

Privacy Policy NEURODELICIOUS CIC

This privacy policy applies between you, the User of the Website neurodelicious.co.uk or a user of our services, and Neurodelicious, the owner and provider of the Website and servoces.

Neurodelicious takes the privacy of your information very seriously. This privacy policy applies to our use of any and all Data collected by us or provided by you in relation to your use of the Website.

Definitions and interpretation



In this privacy policy, the following definitions are used:

Data: Data collectively all information that you submit to Neurodelicious via the Website. This definition incorporates, where applicable, the definitions provided in the Data Protection Laws;

Cookies: a small text file placed on your computer by this Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website. Details of the cookies used by this Website are set out in the clause below (Cookies);

Data Protection Laws: Any applicable law relating to the processing of personal Data, including but not limited to the GDPR, and any national implementing and supplementary laws, regulations and secondary legislation;



GDPR: The UK General Data Protection Regulation;

Neurodelicious: we or us

UK and EU Cookie Law: The Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 as amended by the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 & the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2018;

User or you: Any third party that accesses the Website and is not either (i) employed by Neurodelicious and acting in the course of their employment or (ii) engaged as a consultant or otherwise providing services to Neurodelicious and accessing the Website in connection with the provision of such services; and

Website: The website that you are currently using, www.neurodelicious.co.uk, and any sub-domains of this site unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions.



- In this privacy policy, unless the context requires a different interpretation:
- a. the singular includes the plural and vice versa;
- b. references to sub-clauses, clauses, schedules or appendices are to sub-clauses, clauses, schedules or appendices of this privacy policy;
- c. a reference to a person includes firms, companies, government entities, trusts and partnerships;
- d. "including" is understood to mean "including without limitation";
- e. reference to any statutory provision includes any modification or amendment of it;
- f. the headings and sub-headings do not form part of this privacy policy.



Scope of this privacy policy

- 3. This privacy policy applies only to the actions of Neurodelicious and Users with respect to this Website. It does not extend to any websites that can be accessed from this Website including, but not limited to, any links we may provide to social media websites.
- 4. For purposes of the applicable Data Protection Laws, Neurodelicious is the "data controller". This means that Neurodelicious determines the purposes for which, and the manner in which, your Data is processed.

Data collected

- 5. We may collect the following Data, which includes personal Data, from you:
- a. name;
- b. contact Information such as email addresses and telephone numbers;



- c. demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests;
- d. IP address (automatically collected);
- e. web browser type and version (automatically collected);
- f. operating system (automatically collected);
- g. a list of URLs starting with a referring site, your activity on this Website, and the site you exit to (automatically collected);

in each case, in accordance with this privacy policy.

How we collect Data

- 6. We collect Data in the following ways:
- a. data is given to us by you;
- b. data is received from other sources; and



c. data is collected automatically.

Cookies.

- 1. Neurodelicious (we or us or our) uses cookies when you visit our website, www.neurodelicious.co.uk, (the Website) to help customise the Website and improve your experience using the Website.
- This policy applies between you, the user of this Website, and us, Neurodelicious, the owner and provider of this Website.
- 3. When you visit the Website, and before your Website places cookies on your computer, you will be presented with a message bar requesting your consent to set those cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of cookies, you are enabling us to provide a better experience and service. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of these cookies; however, certain features of the Website may not function fully or as intended.

Type of cookie Purpose

Strictly necessary cookies

These are cookies that are required for the operation of the Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of the Website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.

Analytical/performance cookies

These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by



ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Functionality cookies

These are used to recognise you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region). By using the Website, you agree to our placement of functionality cookies.

Targeting cookies

These cookies record your visit to our Website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our Website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.
